Hole 5 is a short par 4 where you actually leave the course to play your tee shot, measuring in at 284 yards. The green can be driven from the tee but there are dangers lurking, you have out of bounds down the left and two green side bunkers to contend with. You can hit a long iron here and still leave a short pitch in. A good birdie opportunity, and you might need one with what comes next.

Hole 6, 465 yards par 4 this hole is stroke index 1 on the card and is a tough one. The hole dog legs slightly to the left and the fairway is tree lined on both sides. The green is protected by a ditch that runs in front and a bunker too. If you par this it will feel like a birdie.

Hole 7, is 375 yards par 4, the hole dog legs to the right from the tee and will suit a fade. The green slopes from right to left and is protected by 2 bunkers so will you need to be accurate with your approach shot.

Hole 8, is 303 yards par 4, you can drive this green from the tee and the line is just left of the marker post. The fairway slopes from right to left and there is a bunker on the front left edge to gather up any wayward tee shots. The green itself is relatively flat and this hole could offer you a birdie if you get your tee shot right.

Hole 9, is a par 4, 385 yards. The hole is straight down with two fairway bunkers to capture any errant tee shots. The fairway is reasonably wide and tree lined on both sides. The green has two bunkers waiting for any wayward approach shots. This is a lovely looking hole from the tee with the club house in the background, and is a nice end to the front nine.

Hole 10, is a par 5 measuring 488 yards, there are two fairway bunkers waiting to catch any misguided drives so it might be the safe play to lay up short of these and play 3 to the green. The green is very tricky and slopes back left to front with a bunker on the front right corner. I would take par here to start my back nine.

Hole 11, 440 yards par 4 the fairway is tight and tree lined down both sides try to be straight down here. There is a pond that runs in front of the green and a bunker front right edge. The green is two tiered but with all the trouble in front of the green you could be forgiven for finding the back tier. This hole is one of the toughest on the course.

Hole 12, is a par 3, 175 yards. The green slopes from back to front and will hold a good tee shot, try to leave your ball under the hole for an easier putt. With a good iron here you could be looking at birdie, but only if you avoid the green side bunkers.

Hole 13, 382 yards par 4 the hole dog legs right from the tee with a fairway bunker well placed to catch any wayward drives, as you get round the corner you have a ditch about 50 yards short of the green and 3 green side bunkers. The green has quiet a few roles on it and depending on pin position can leave a very difficult putt.
