Over the summer holidays there have been lots of opportunities for girls to play golf at Leicestershire clubs. Leicestershire & Rutland Ladies County Golf Association have run a series of Flag 50 and stableford events at six county clubs. This has been made possible by a Development Grant from the English Women's Golf Association. The clubs involved were Lutterworth, Birstall, Hinckley, Forest Hill, Glen Gorse and Scraptoft. Forty five girls took part overall, twenty two in the Flag 50 and twenty three in the stableford.

The Flag 50 is for young players without a handicap or with a junior club handicap between 37 and 54. Our youngest competitor was seven year old Abigail Wilkin from Kilworth Springs and the oldest was fourteen year old Alice Watkins from Lutterworth. The girls play in age groups with their best three scores counting for the Series results.
