

Hole 7, 157 yards par 3. This is a nice straight forward par 3, the green is protected by 3 bunkers. You tee off slightly higher than the green. The green itself is relatively flat and could offer you a birdie.

Hole 8, 552 yards par 5, this hole is stroke index 1 on the card. You tee off from an elevated tee position with out of bounds lurking down the left hand side and trees down the right. The ground drops away and then quickly climbs again so your tee shot will pitch into the up rise. The hole dog legs after about 3—350 yards to the left and slowly drops down again to the green. The green is a nice flat target but is protected by sand. Par is a good score here.

Hole 9, 402 yards par 4, a nice finish to the front nine. The hole dog legs to the right and you can cut the corner off the tee to leave a shorter approach shot. The approach is to a slightly elevated green which again is well protected by sand.

Hole 10, 428 yards par 4, the back nine starts with a nice straight par 4 the fairway is lined on both sides by trees so you need to straight off the tee. The green has one bunker protecting it.

Hole 11, 409 yards par 4, the hole doglegs slightly round to the left and the fairway slopes right to left so you need to be accurate from the tee. Your approach will be to a slightly elevated green with a bunker on the front right edge. This hole could give you a birdie.

Hole 12, 279 yards par 4, a short but tricky par 4. The hole is uphill all the way from the tee to the green, and slopes left to right as well. The approach shot is a tricky one as the green is elevated and protected again by sand. The green has many slopes on it so be careful when putting.

Hole 13, 372 yards par 4, the tee shot is from an elevated tee and the view of the hole is superb. The fairway slopes slightly from right to left and there are trees down by both sides. The green is protected by sand but this hole could offer you a birdie opportunity.

Hole 14, 452 yards par 4, this hole is a tough and long par 4. The drive is a tricky one with a big tree in the middle of the fairway. Take a par here and it will feel like a birdie.

Hole 15, 547 yards par 5, a long but straight par 5 it is a tough driving hole has the fairway is narrow and tree lined. There is a ditch that runs across the fairway 150 yards out and the green has one green side bunker. The safe play is 3 to the green.

Hole 16, 195 yards par 3, you are playing to a two tiered green that slopes from back to front so the green will hold a good approach shot. If you get on the right level off the tee you could make 2, but a 3 will do here.

Hole 17, 340 yards par 4, This is a very picturesque hole you tee off from a narrow tree lined tee area, the fairway opens up on the right hand side but remains tree lined up the left. Two big trees on the fairway and the hole climbs all the way from tee to the two tiered green. Getting the right tee shot is essential here or you could be in trouble.

Hole 18, 163 yards par 3. The final hole is a nice par 3 the tee is elevated high above the green so you can probably go down a club here. There are 3 green side bunkers waiting to catch any wayward tee shots, get it on line and you could end with a bird-
